We look forward to your arrival at Majestic Farm for this competition. Please review the following information regarding the event:

1. The **class schedule, stabling and other information** is posted on the Majestic Farm website: [www.majesticfarm.net](http://www.majesticfarm.net). 2. A **Check-in Booth** will be located near the facility entrance. Your horse's health papers (current Coggins and Vaccination record) will be checked and you will be directed to your stabling and parking. **Proof of Rhino/Flu vaccination must be dated between 3/17/17-9/7/17.**
3. The **Show Office** is located at the end of Barn C. Office hours: Wednesday: 12:00 noon-8:00 pm; Thursday-Saturday: 7:00 am-7:00 pm; Sunday: 7:00 am-1 hour after show ends. You can pick up your packets and numbers starting at 12:00 noon on Wednesday.
4. **Stabling.** After Monday, September 11, please contact Stable Manager, Amy Struzzieri (845-220-7206 or [Brookesedge@aol.com](mailto:Brookesedge@aol.com)) with any questions about your stabling. Please be reminded that you are not permitted to modify or damage stabling by inserting screw eyes or nails into any part of the wood and/or metal. Night Security from Wednesday through Saturday nights will be provided at no additional charge to competitors.
5. **Shavings.** No initial bedding will be supplied. Must have minimum two bags or pay disposal fee. Shavings are \$10.00 per bag. Order on entry form or at show office during office hours. Competitors not ordering shavings will be charged a disposal fee of \$20.00 per horse stall.
6. **Parking.** Parking on grounds will be in designated areas only. There is limited parking on the grounds for horse trailers and vans. Parking attendants will be at the stable entrance for parking assistance. Over flow parking will be at the Clermont County fairgrounds. A map will be given to each competitor at the stable entrance for off-site parking. There is also limited RV parking onsite. Additional RV parking is also located at the fairgrounds.
7. **Schooling** schedules will be posted on the bulletin boards at the stables and the show office. Schooling starts at 12:00 pm on Wednesday.
8. **Musical Freestyles:** Music must be on good quality CD and turned in to the Show Office at least 24 hours before scheduled ride(s). Music must be on a separate CD for each ride.
9. **Sound checks.** Riders wishing to have a sound check must sign up in Show Office at the time of check-in. Management cannot guarantee time slots for sound checks will be available for those signing up less than 24 hours before their scheduled ride(s). Sound checks will be available starting after the end of classes on Thursday by signing up in the show office. Limited sounds checks will also be available from 7:00-7:30 am on Friday-Sunday, again by signing up in the show office.
10. **Bridle Numbers.** All horses must have a bridle number on at all times when out of their stalls. NO EXCEPTIONS.
11. **Nightwatch Services** will be provided by Amy Struzzieri from 9 pm – 5 am for \$10 per horse, per night. She can be contacted at 845-220-7206 or [brookesedge@aol.com](mailto:brookesedge@aol.com)

14. **Preliminary scores** can be viewed on computer kiosks located inside the Awards building behind Barn C.
15. **Important information** will be posted on the bulletin boards at the stables & show office. Check the bulletin boards for day sheets, schooling schedules and other important information.

- 16. Awards Schedule.** Riders placing in the Great American/USDF Regional Championship classes must be present, mounted and in full riding attire for award ceremonies (eight places for all Championship classes). Failure, without prior permission of the competition manager, in consultation with the Technical Delegate, the Awards coordinator, and the USDF representative, to be present and properly attired will eliminate the official score and placing, and the next highest score will move up in placing. In case of inclement weather, unmounted ceremonies may be held. All ceremonies will be in Ring 2 during the lunch break or at the end of each day's competition.
- 17. Food vendors:** Four food vendors will be operating Wednesday from 12:00 pm – 6:00 pm and Thursday-Sunday, starting at 6:00 am for breakfast and remaining open until the end of the show each day. Vendors are Lo-Key Pizza, United Dairy Farmers, Eastgate Brew and View and BBQ Street.

From Dayton, OH: 75 South to 275 East to exit 59, Milford Parkway.  
From Columbus, OH: 71 South to 275 East to Exit 59, Milford Parkway  
From Lexington, KY: 75 North to 275 East to Exit 59A, Milford Parkway  
From Louisville, KY: 71 North to 75 North to 275 East to Exit 59A, Milford Parkway
- From Exit 59, Follow Milford Parkway towards and past the Showcase Cinemas, Target. At the first light after Target, continue on Milford Parkway. At your second light, you will be at US 50, cross US 50. This then becomes East State Route 131. Go about 6 miles until you come to the intersection of State Route 132 and State Route 131 (Williams Corner). At this light, take a right and go south on State Route 132 about a mile. The farm will be on your left.
- 22. Reminders**
- Horses entered in a Regional Championship class cannot be taken off the “Designated Competition Grounds” as outlined on the posted grounds map from the time of arrival on the grounds until after their last championship class.
  - Under penalty of disqualification from all championship classes for the horse/rider combination, within 24 hours prior and at no time during a USEF/USDF Championship competition may any horse entered in that Championship competition be ridden by anyone other than the rider entered in the Championship competition on that horse (Exception: grooms riding on loose rein). Further, any horse entered in a Championship competition, even if entered at two levels, must be ridden by the same rider throughout the competition. Note: This rule applies from 8:00 am on Wednesday until the end of the show on Sunday (even if the horse finished his championship classes earlier in the week).
  - From the time you arrive on the grounds, protective headgear is required for anyone mounted on a horse at any time, including non-competing riders and riders on non-competing horses.
