### Qualifying System:

1. To qualify for the Majestic Farm Winter or Summer Finals, horse and rider combination must compete in at least three of the Majestic Farm schooling shows within the 6th month series and earn a total of one qualifying score. Judges can be the same.
2. Qualification is based on horse/rider combination. If a new rider wishes to qualify with that horse, they must requalify.
3. No Limit on number of horses on which a rider may qualify.
4. Rider may also compete in finals AND schooling show (March 2024 and September 2024) to receive scores for the next series.
5. Winter Finals scores do NOT count towards Summer Series and vice versa. Only Schooling Show scores count towards qualification.

### Championship Rules:

1. All tests must be ridden from memory.
2. All horses competing in Majestic Farm Finals must remain on the grounds for the duration of participation.
3. Mounted Awards ceremony will be scheduled for each championship class. You must be present to receive your award.
4. If there is a tie the collective marks will determine first, second, and/ or third.
5. Test ridden for Finals will be highest test of level.
6. For freestyle championship class rider must provide the show with music in CD form.

### Championship Dress Code

1. All riders must meet USDF show attire requirements to compete in Championship class.
2. To receive awards mounted, Rider must be in show attire mounted on horse. Horse must have white polo wraps or boots and braided.

1. Champion & Reserve Champion awards
2. 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> place awards
